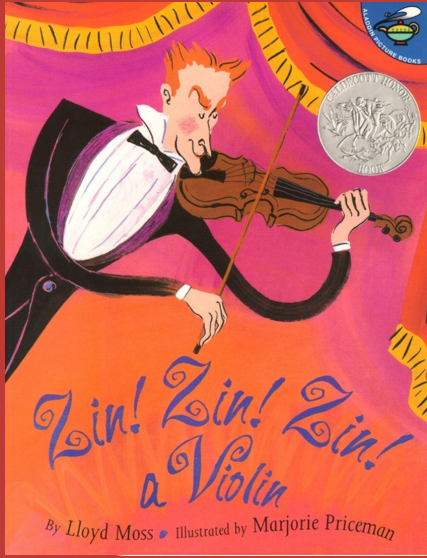

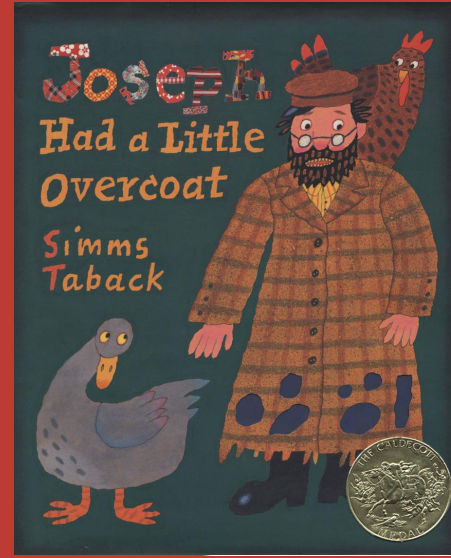


## ZIN! ZIN! ZIN! : A VIOLIN

Ten instruments take their parts one by one in a musical performance.

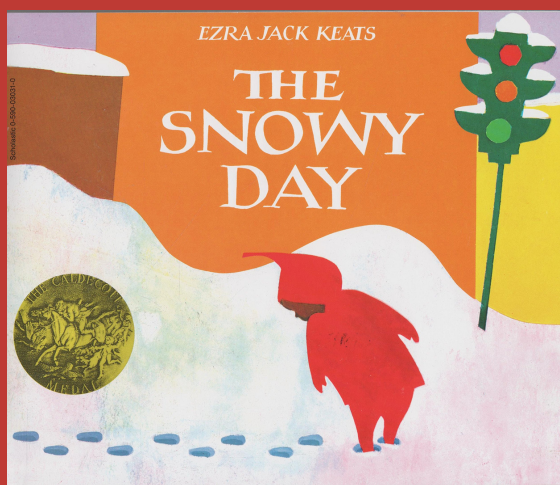


## JOSEPH HAD A LITTLE OVERCOAT

A very old overcoat is recycled numerous times into a variety of garments.

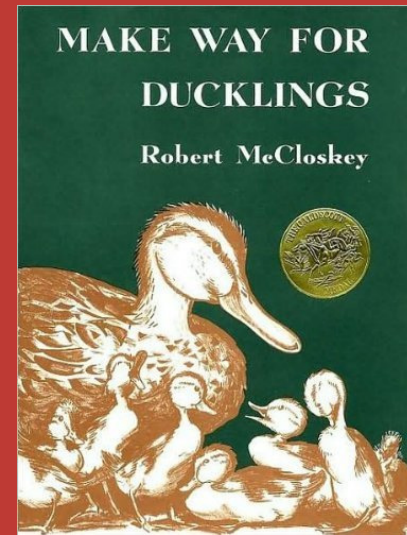


## THE SNOWY DAY

The adventures of a little boy in the city on a very snowy day.

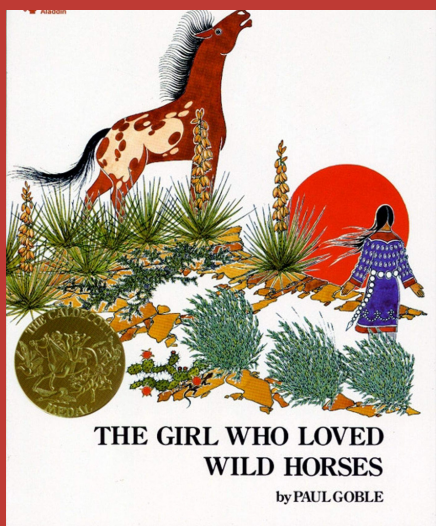


## MAKE WAY FOR DUCKLINGS

Mr. and Mrs. Mallard proudly return to their home in the Boston Public Garden with their eight offspring.

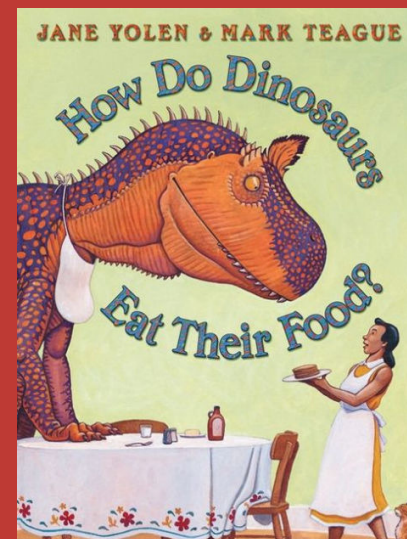


## THE GIRL WHO LOVED WILD HORSES

Though she is fond of her people, a girl prefers to live among the wild horses where she is truly happy and free.

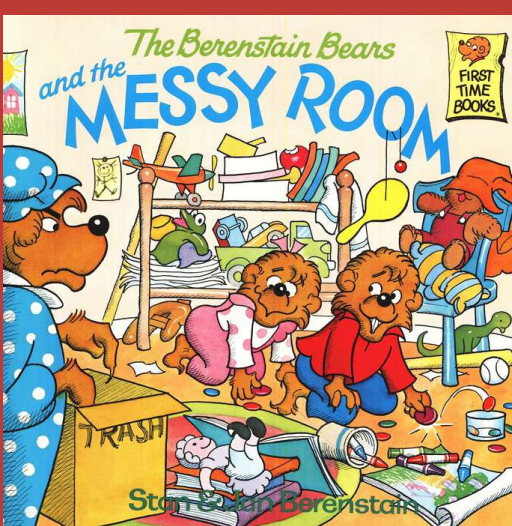


## HOW DO DINOSAURS EAT THEIR FOOD?

Just like kids, dinosaurs have a difficult time learning to behave at the table.

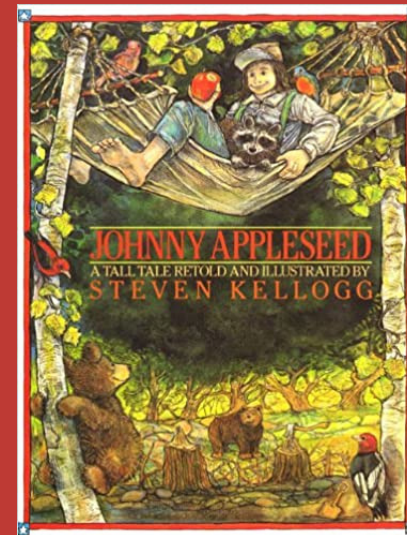


## THE BERENSTAIN BEARS AND THE MESSY ROOM

The entire Bear family becomes involved in an attempt to clean and organize the cubs' messy room.

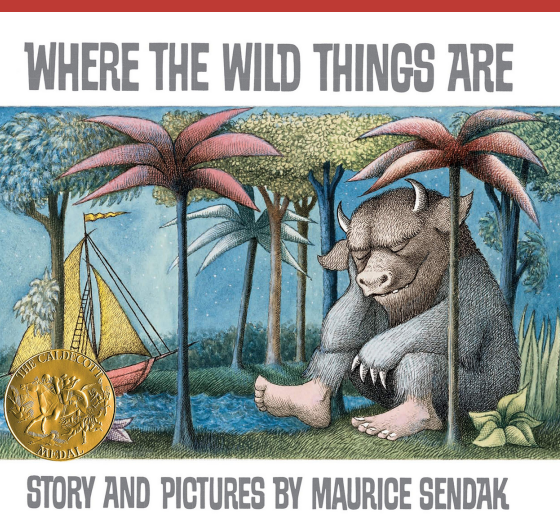


## JOHNNY APPLESEED: A TALL TALE

resents the life of John Chapman, better known as Johnny Appleseed, describing his love of nature, his kindness to animals, and his physical fortitude.

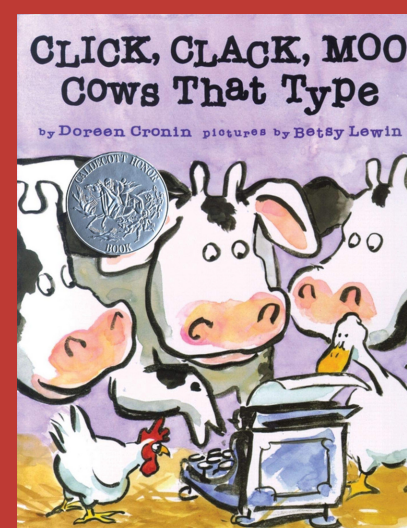


## WHERE THE WILD THINGS ARE

A naughty little boy, sent to bed without his supper, sails to the land of the wild things where he becomes their king.

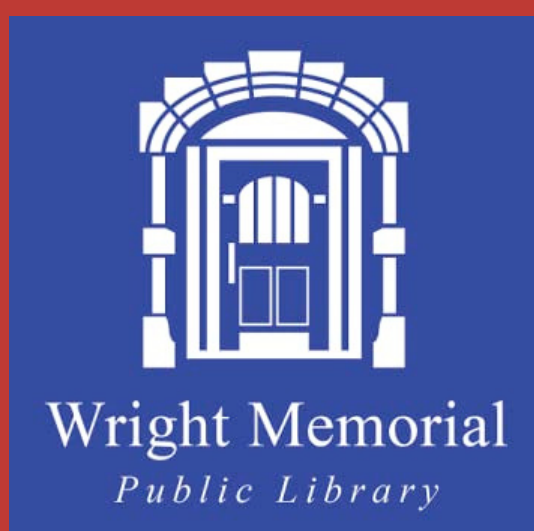


## CLICK, CLACK, MOO : COWS THAT TYPE
