


<u>Binti: The Complete Trilogy by</u> <u>Nnedi Okorafor</u>


The Lesson by Cadwell Turnbull

Inspired by the civilizations of the Pre-Columbian Americas, this is an epic fantasy adventure of celestial prophecies, political intrigue, and forbidden magic.




Magic for Liars by Sarah Gailey


The Poppy War by R.F. Kuang


<u>The Record Keeper by Agnes</u> <u>Gomillion</u>
